ARTICLE 11

"CP-3" PLANNED HIGHWAY SERVICE COMMERCIAL DISTRICT REGULATIONS

Sections:

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- 11-101 <u>Application</u>: The regulations set forth in this Article, or set forth elsewhere in these Regulations when referred to in this Article, are the regulations in the "CP-3" Planned Highway Service Commercial District. The purpose of this District is to provide space in appropriate locations within the incorporated cities, particularly along the existing major highways where a general mixture of commercial and service activity now exists, for those uses of a more intensive nature that are clearly commercial in nature but which require more land area to function efficiently.
- 11-102 <u>Use Regulations</u>: In District "CP-3," no building, structure, land or premises shall be used and no building or structure shall be hereafter erected constructed, reconstructed, moved or altered, except for one or more of the following uses:
 - 1. Any use permitted in the "CP-2" Planned Neighborhood Commercial District.
 - 2. Boat sales and service, including storage yard.
 - 3. Farm machinery sales and service, including storage yard.
 - 4. Manufactured home and trailer sales and service, including display yard.
- 11-103 <u>Plan Approval Guidelines</u>: The Plan Approval Guidelines, including site plan submission and content requirements, are contained in Article 15 of these Regulations.
- 11-104 <u>Performance Standards</u>: The Performance Standards for permitted uses are contained in Article 16 of these Regulations.
- 11-105 <u>Parking Regulations</u>: The Parking Regulations for permitted uses are contained in Article 17 of these Regulations.
- 11-106 Off-Street Loading Regulations: The Off-Street Loading Regulations for permitted uses are contained in Article 18 of these Regulations.
- 11-107 <u>Sign Regulations</u>: The Sign Regulations are contained in Article 19 of these Regulations.

11-108 <u>Height, Area and Bulk Regulations</u>: In the "CP-3" Planned Highway Service Commercial District, the height of buildings, the minimum dimensions of lots and yards, and the minimum lot area on any lot shall be as follows:

- 1. <u>Height</u>: Buildings or structures shall not exceed 35 feet and/or 3 stories in height.
- 2. Front Yard: The depth of the front yard shall be at least 30 feet.
- 3. <u>Side Yard</u>: There shall be a side yard on each side of a building. No side yard shall be less than 20 feet.
- 4. Rear Yard: The depth of the rear yard shall be at least 20 feet.
- 5. <u>Lot Dimensions</u>: The minimum width of a lot shall be 150 feet. The minimum depth of a lot shall be 150 feet.
- 6. <u>Lot Area</u>: Every building hereafter erected, constructed, reconstructed, moved or altered shall provide a minimum lot area of 25,000 square feet.

The Height, Area and Bulk Regulations are also set forth in the chart of Article 20. Said chart, and all notations and requirements shown therein, shall have the same force and effect as if all the notations and requirements were fully set forth or described herein.

11-109 <u>Supplementary Height, Area and Bulk Regulations</u>: The Supplementary Height, Area and Bulk Regulations are contained in Article 21 of these Regulations.

11-110 <u>Supplementary Use Regulations</u>: The Supplementary Use Regulations, including permitted Conditional Uses and Accessory Uses, are contained in Article 22 of these Regulations.
